"Erasmus - Mobility for Studies (KA103/2020)"

Erasmus studies 2021/22 – terms and conditions applicable to students departing in August or travelling by plane in September

Due to the fact that the new Erasmus+ project comes into force in September 2021 and the funding assigned to UW from the new project is insufficient, Vice-Rector for Students and Quality of Teaching, prof. Sławomir Żółtek has decided to pay out grants of the students starting their mobility in August or travelling to host universities by plane in September from the ongoing Erasmus 103/2020 project, in which the monthly grant amounts are the same as in the 2021/22 project:

- 520 EUR Denmark, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden;
- 500 EUR Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Greece, Spain, The Netherlands, Malta, Germany, Portugal, Italy;
- 450 EUR Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Lithuania, Latvia, Rep. of North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, Hungary.

The deadlines for submitting post-mobility documents have been amended as follows: 31.03.2022 for students coming back after the first semester and 15.09.2022 for students coming back after the second semester and full academic year.

All students are required to submit a scan of their **Student mobility form** (**Zgłoszenie kandydata na wyjazd**). Please download the form from your USOSweb profile (*Student mobility > mobilities > view > Print form*), have it signed by the mobility coordinator and the Dean/ Head of the Didactic Unit. As it may be difficult to obtain both signatures during the holiday season, forms with one signature will be accepted (coordinator's or Dean's / Head of the Didactic Unit). The forms may be signed traditionally or with the use of a qualified electronic signature.

Students receiving the funding from the Erasmus KA103/2020 project are obliged to complete Online Linguistic Support (OLS) tests. Detailed information on the OLS tests and signing financial agreements will be communicated in subsequent announcements.
